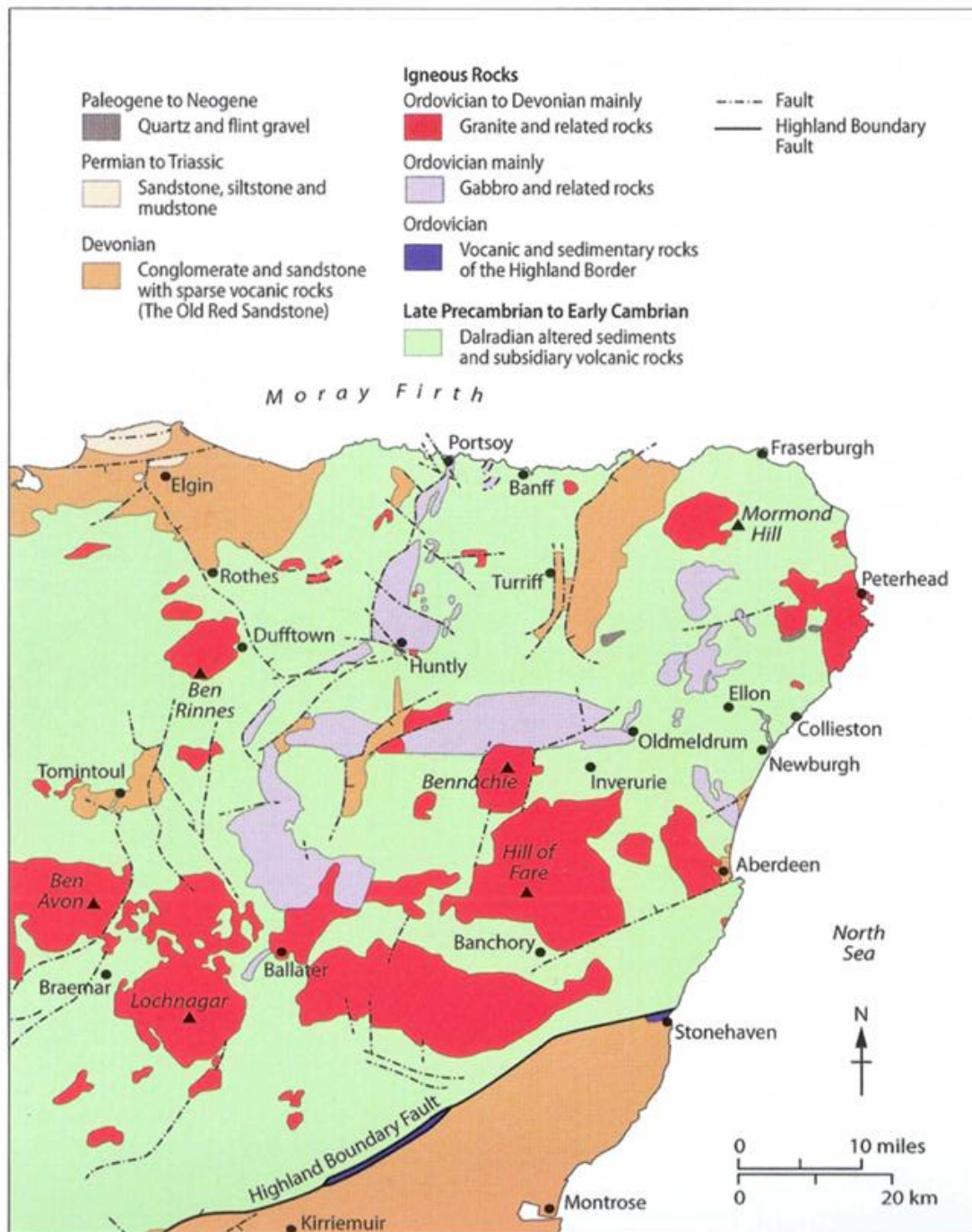


Geological Map of North East Scotland



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Dalradian rocks dominate the geology of the North East. These sedimentary layers have been much altered by heat and pressure. Granites formed in the crust punctuate the North East as prominent landscape features. Old Red Sandstone are also fairly predominant around Elgin, east of Turriff and south of the Highland Boundary line.
